## ARTIST STATEMENT:

"THE EDGE" | "SPACEWALK" | "SAPPHIRE ROAD"

THIS PROJECT IS A JOURNEY STARTING IN THE DARK AND WALKING UNEXPECTED WAYS FORWARD IN "THE EDGE"; DRIFTING THROUGH SPACE AND TIME IN "SPACEWALK"; AND FINDING LIFE AND RENEWAL IN "SAPPHIRE ROAD".

These three pieces tell a story individually and also together. Footprints are a marker of a path taken by the viewer, leading them through these worlds. Sometimes you have to keep walking through darkness, reality, dreams, space, imagination, time, and ideas to understand anything; and you have to question everything to finallly find any answers. Through dark times there are always unexpected ways forward, even if frightening. At the Edge, there are two wolves, which one do you feed? Sometimes after finding new ways forward it doesn't feel as we might have imagined, there is a feeling of walking through Space and time, drifting through doors and diners, and looking for light.
